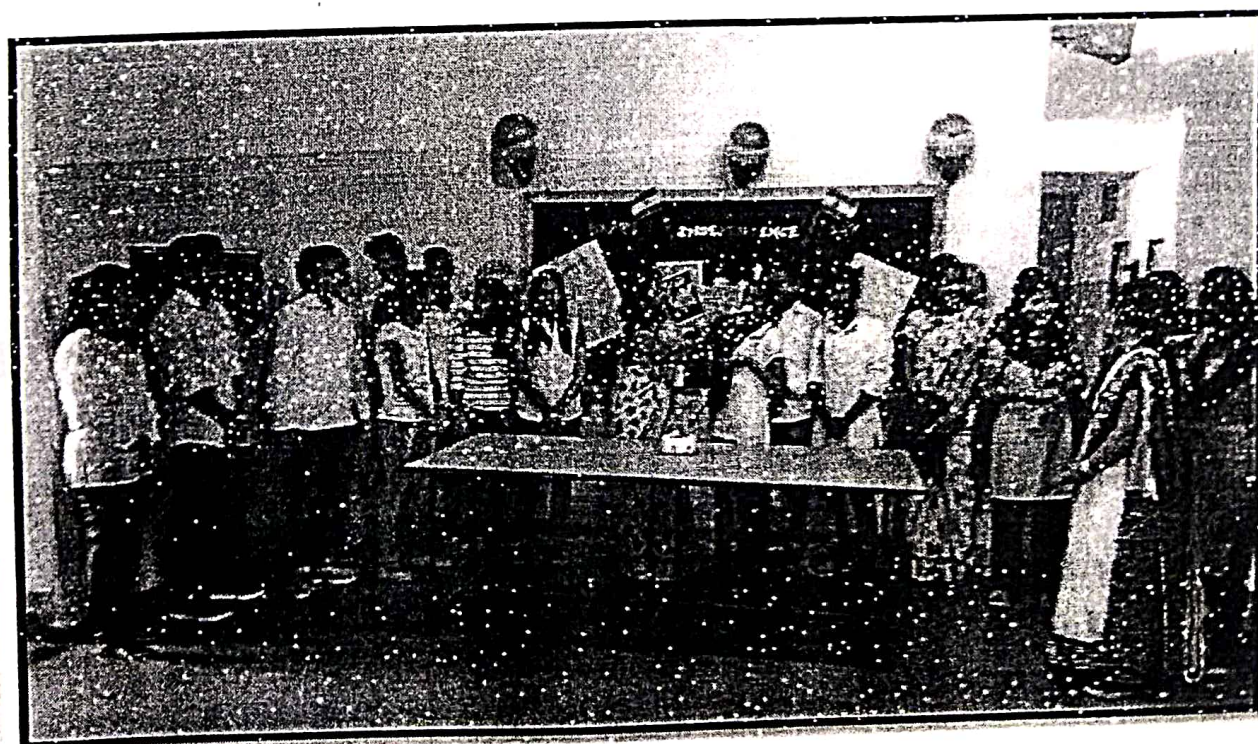

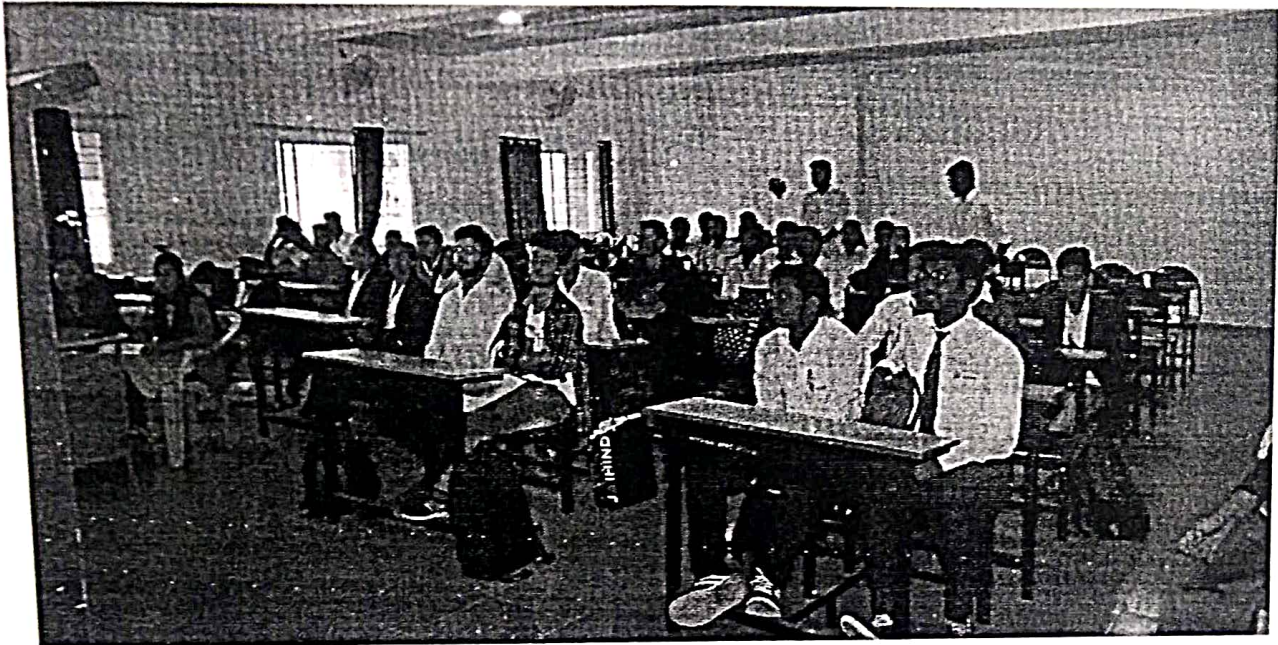
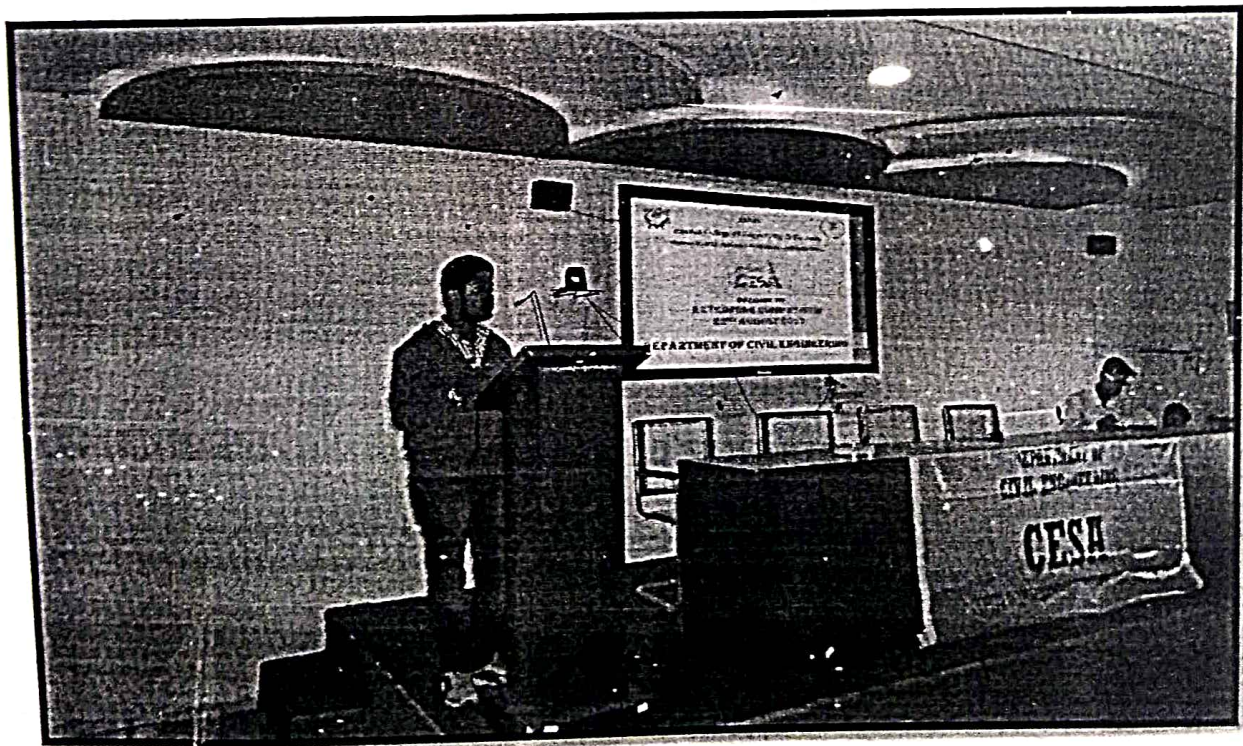


Photo 2 : Student participant delivering the speech.

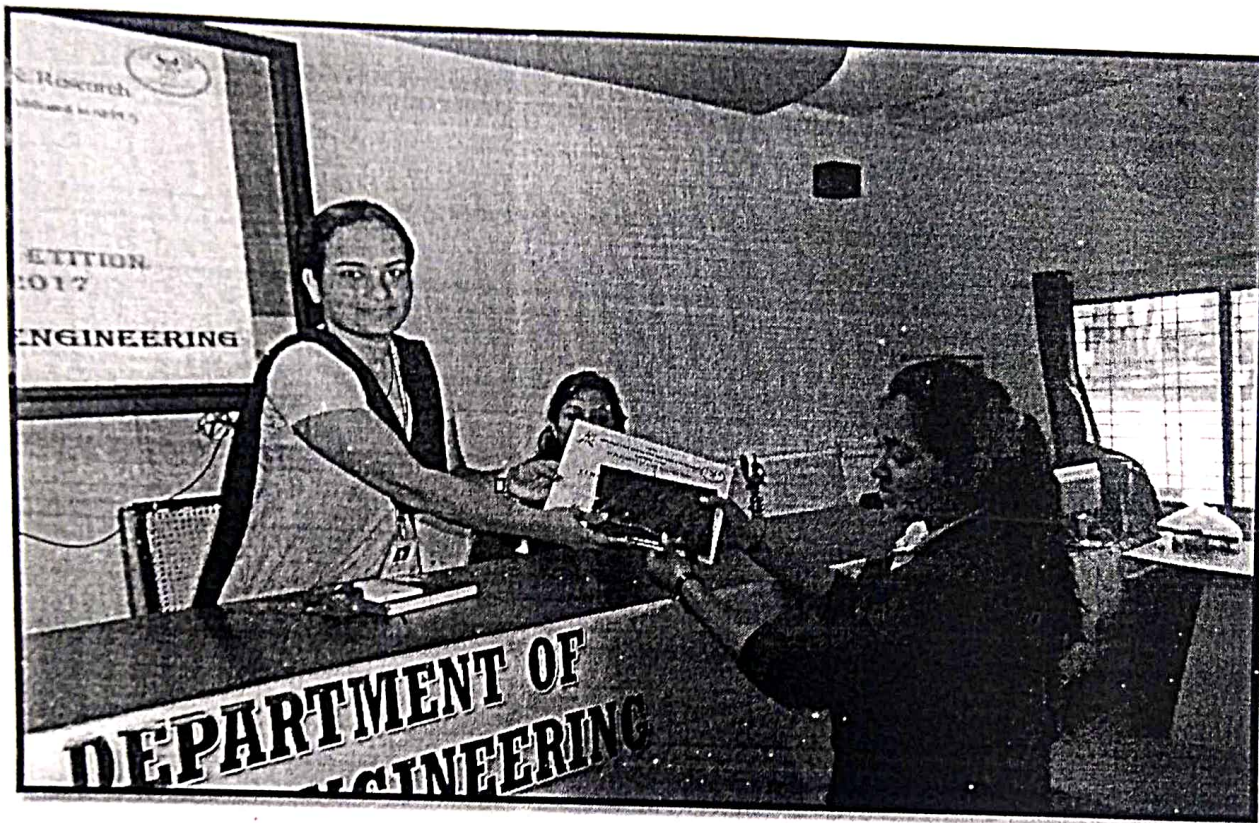

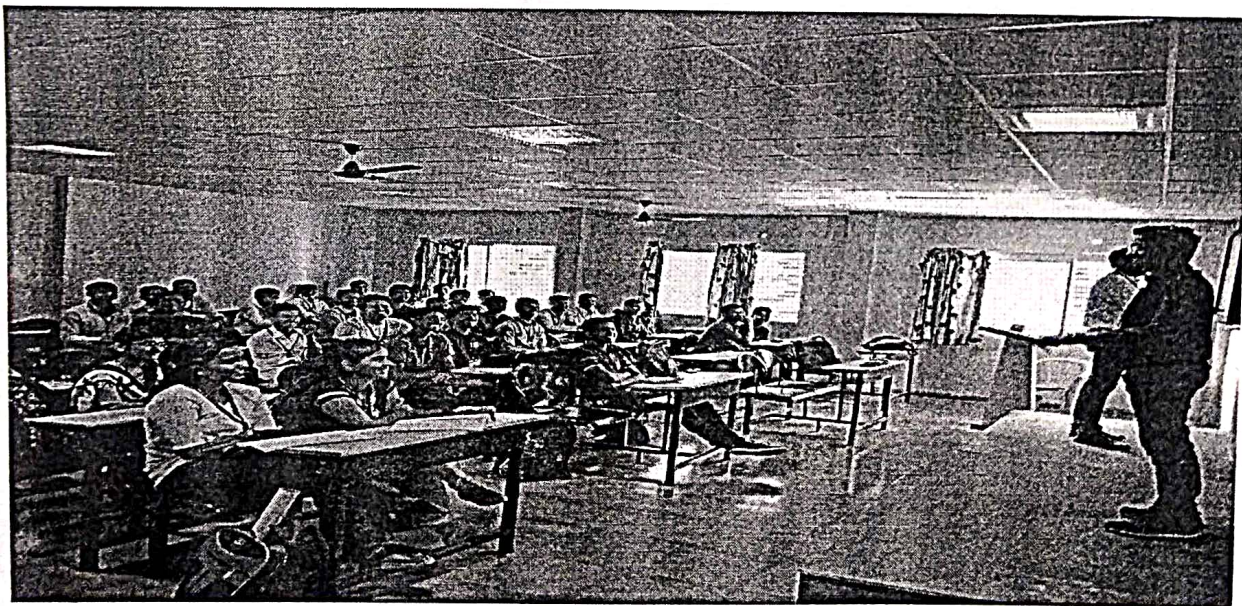

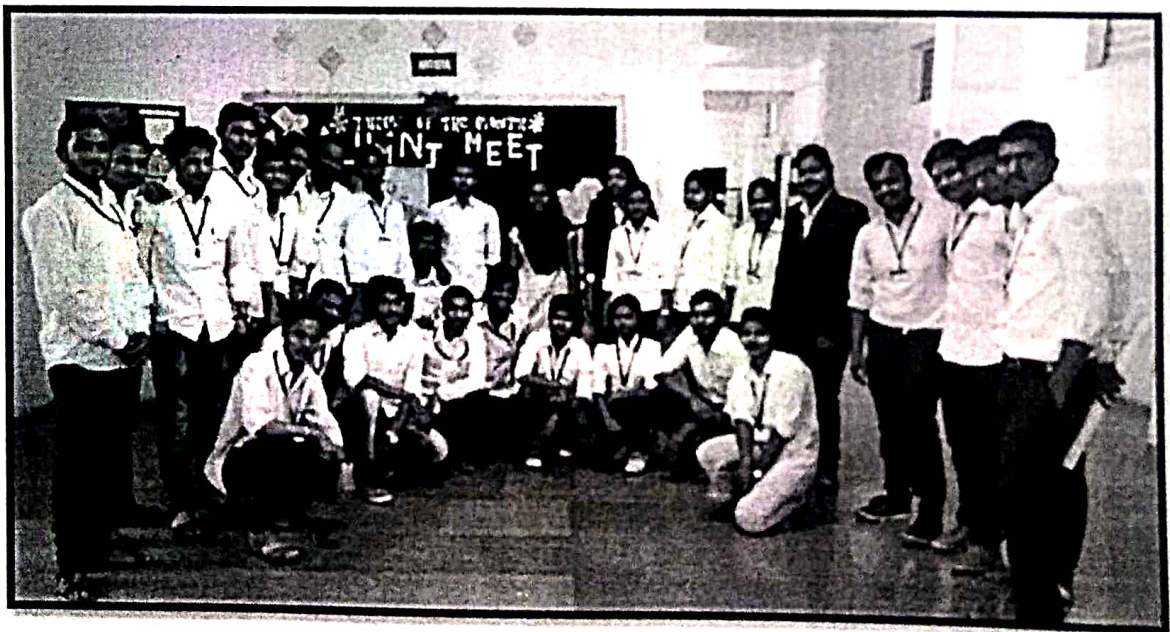


Photo1: Group of Students at ARTISTA board.

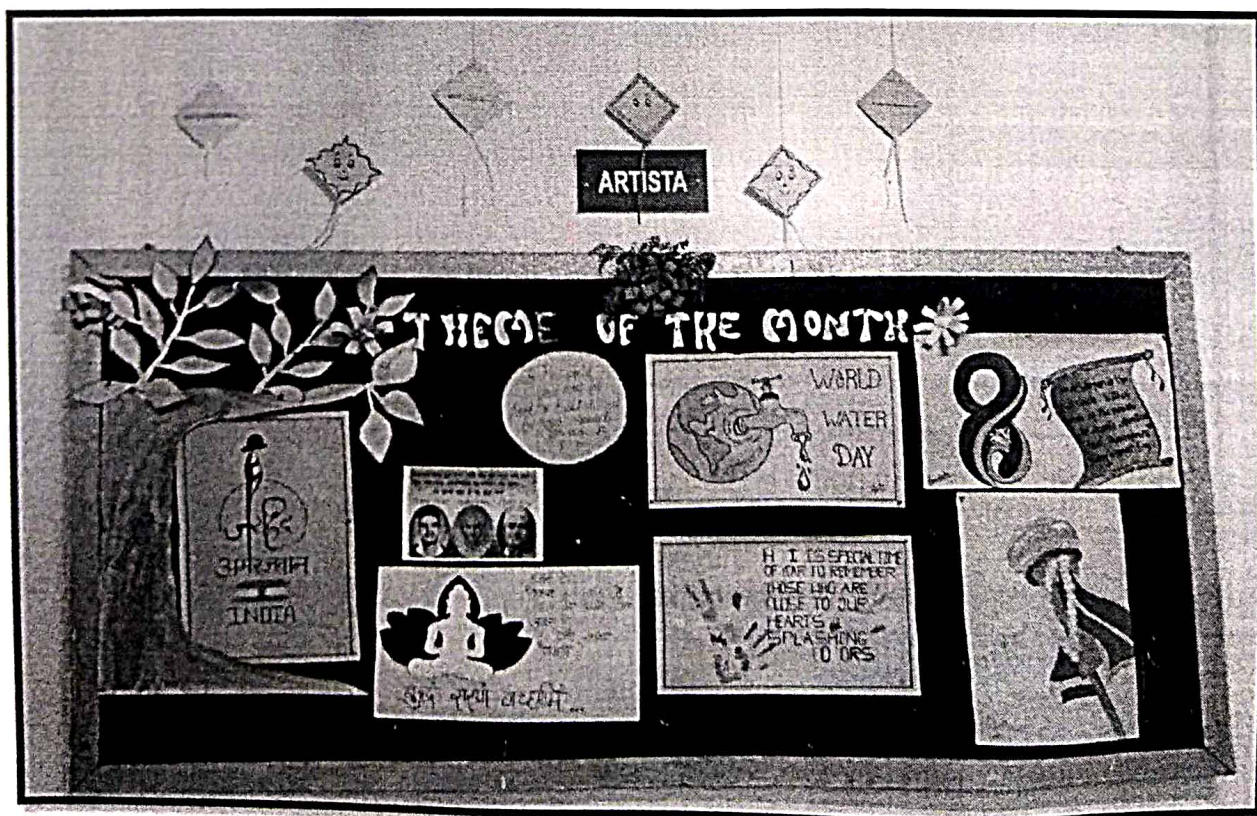
Photo2: Students decorated ARTISTA board for Makar Sankranti celebration.
